PATTERN INSTRUCTIONS TO 'NOT WHAT IT SEEMS'

- A. Let's start by closing the back. This is just one big line, so fit points 1 to 7 onto each other.
Sew with 1cm seam allowance.
- B. Close the left shoulder.
- C. Another long seam in just one piece. Fit point 1 onto the other point 1 and close the seam.
- D. Close the right shoulder.
- E. Seam E contains three pattern pieces. No worries though! Fit the points 1 to 2 onto each other and sew.
- F. Now you have assembled the body of the garment. Hem along lines F. For this I suggest you fold and press 1cm seam allowance twice and then edgestitch it down.
- G. For this step we will line the remaining raw edges in the body. Take the green pattern piece, sew together into one long piece and line all edges labeled G.
- H. Take the triangular piece we hemmed in step F. Edgestitch it into the front right starting from the right shoulder, right sides together.
- I. Leaving 1cm seam allowance again sew lines i together, this time left side onto right side, though! Now the body of the piece is completed.
- J. Getting started on the first sleeve, fit points 1 to 2 onto each other, close.
- K. Closing up the other side of the sleeve, fit points 1 to 2 onto each other again and close.
- L. Now we move on to the left sleeve. First, we have to create a little fold where the arrows are.
Then fit point 1 onto point 1, sew together.
- M. Leaving 2cm seam allowance, close lines M leaving the bit of excess fabric as shown in the pattern piece.
- N. Using 2cm seam allowance again, put points 1 to 2 together and close.
- O. Line O attaches the sleeve to the left shoulder. Just put points 1 to 2 together and close.
- P. Line P closes the right shoulder. Use the points 1 to 2 for orientation and sew together.
- Q. Wow! You have almost finished this DAZZLE-suit! All that is left to do is hem the left sleeve

pressing 1cm down twice and edgestitch-

R -and for the right sleeve we will use the bit of green lining that is left. First, we have to put a larger fold, though. Look for the arrows in the pattern piece, pin and edgestitch it together.
Now you can line the hem of the sleeve- and you are done!

If you want your garment to be extra sturdy, you can topstitch the seam allowance down. I did this with my DAZZLE-piece. Also, I added a zipper to close the collar up to the left side of the neckline.

All pattern pieces have 1cm seam allowance and will be put right sides together unless stated otherwise in the instructions.
