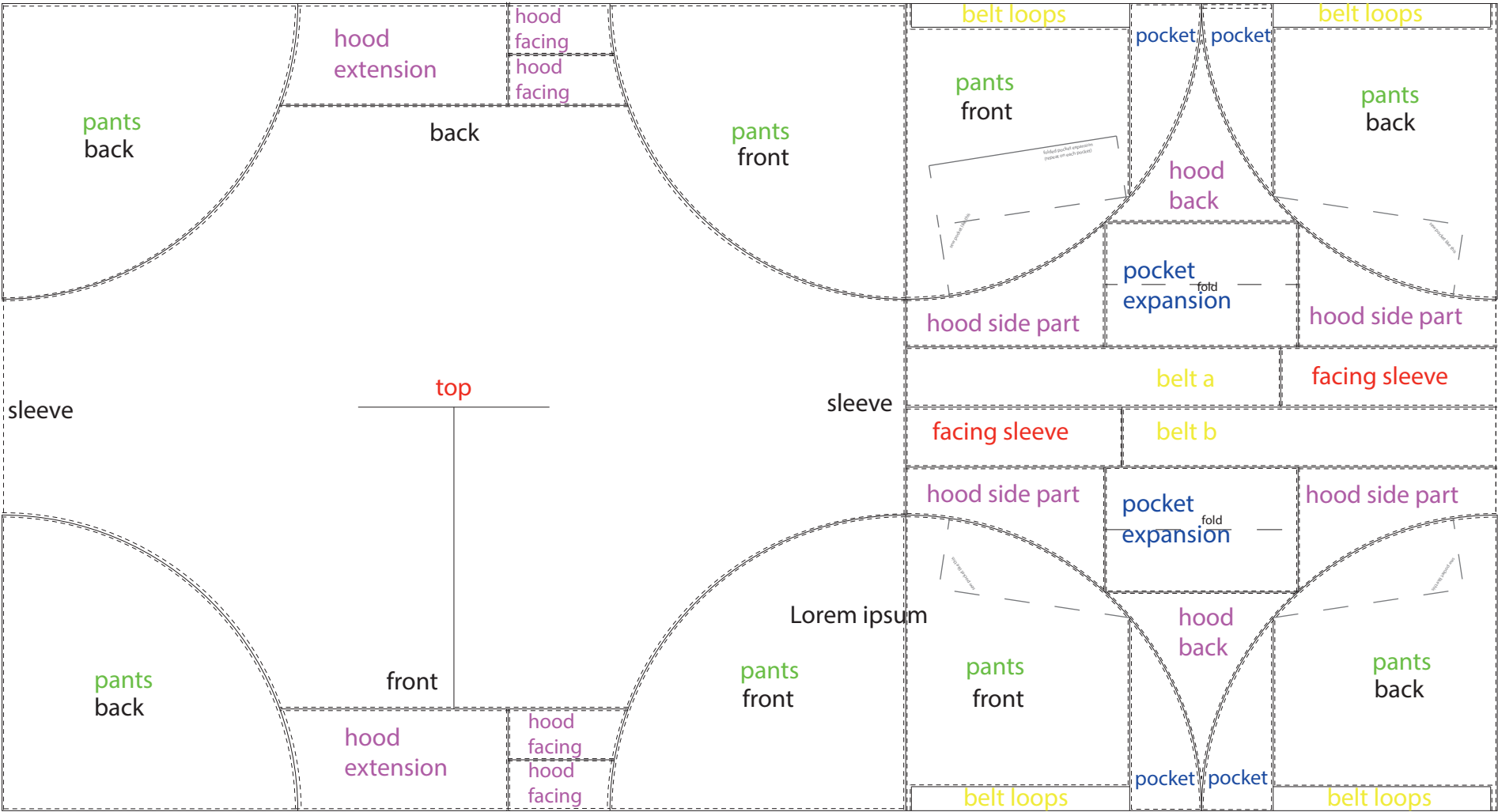

Pattern Instructions

1. First cut out all of the pattern pieces and sort them by color.
2. Start with the pants. Sew front top and low and back top and low together. Then sew the pockets with the pocket expansions together on the front pants as seen on the pattern. Close the side seams and turn the hems up.
3. Next step is the hood. There are 2 equal parts of each hood-pattern, because you sew 2 individual hoods and face them. When you finished the hood, start cutting the top piece along the line (follow the scissors). The horizontal „scissors line“ builds the neckline, where you sew the hood on.
4. There are two sleeve facing parts that you face with the hems of each sleeve.
5. When you sew the pants together with the top part, make sure to sandwich the belt loops in-between the two pieces. You can chose how many belt loops you want, depending on how wide and large you want them. When everything is sewed together, you have only the belt left. Sew belt a on belt b and fold in the middle. Sew the open edges together and leave one side open so you can turn over. (If the edges of two pieces of material are quilted to one another and turned over, this is called turning over.)
6. Close the seam of the centre front as long as needed (until your zipper starts).
